

# Wood River Trail

The Wood River Trail is a community-owned, 32-kilometer, multi-use, year-round path that provides a non-motorized connection between the Wood River Valley communities of Bellevue, Hailey, Ketchum, and Sun Valley. It offers opportunities for walking, running, biking, fishing, horseback riding, Nordic skiing, snowshoeing, and fat biking for users of all ages and abilities.

Regulations governing the Wood River Trail are established by ordinances at both city and county levels.
