 - Inform the Aquatics Manager of any subs or class cancellations.
 - Keep the aquatic center and other spaces clean and organized.
 - Perform work in a safe and efficient manner, be constantly alert and aware of the hazards involved, and know how to apply safety practices and principles in reporting and preventing accidents.
