What Is the Passport for Recreation?

In honor of its 50th anniversary, BCRD invites the community to explore the trails, facilities, and recreation opportunities that make Blaine County such a special place to live.

The Passport for Recreation is a fun, self-guided program designed for families, individuals, and visitors of all ages. Whether you are a longtime participant or discovering something new, the passport invites you to experience BCRD offerings across the valley and celebrate the shared spaces built over five decades.

How It Works

1. Pick up a Passport for Recreation at FitWorks in the Community Campus: 1050 Fox Acres Road, Hailey.
2. Visit the BCRD trails, facilities, and recreation spots listed in the Passport. See specific locations below.
3. Collect a stamp for each experience you complete.
4. Once you have collected all 8 stamps, return your completed passport to the Community Campus to receive a prize.

enjoy discovering recreation in your own backyard and beyond.**

Why Participate?

The Passport for Recreation is more than checking boxes and snagging stamps. It is an experience! You are invited to explore miles of trails, visit new places, and celebrate the amenities that generations of community members helped create. Every stamp represents a moment of movement, connection, and shared pride in Blaine County.

Prizes

When you complete the passport, turn it in to receive a special 50th anniversary prize, which may include commemorative BCRD items or recreation-related rewards. Prizes may vary throughout the year.

How to Find a Location Specific Passport Stamp

Fixed passport stamp locations will have a sign saying **Passport Stamp Here** with a hanging stamp.

Galena Lodge & Trails:

Stamp can be found on the trailhead sign on the Galena Lodge lawn by the flag poles.

Aquatic Center:

Stamp can be found on the outside of the Aquatic Center building to the left of the front doors.

Quigley Trails Park:

Stamp can be found on the trailhead sign near the pump track.

Wood River Trail:

Hailey: Stamp can be found on the Fox Acres Road trailhead sign

Ketchum: Stamp can be found on the Elkhorn Road trailhead sign

Harriman Trail:

Stamp can be found on the trailhead sign on the West side of Highway 75 at the SNRA headquarters.
